Reading

The truth – tweens, teens and technology!

We all know that young people spend a lot of time in front of computer screens. In a survey of 2,600 children, tweens (children aged 8–12 years old) spend about four and a half hours a day on a device, while teens (aged 13–18 years old) average six and a half hours a day.

The favourite devices of both age groups are smartphones. Most have one, and spend four hours a day on it. Generally, boys prefer playing games, while girls spend more time on social media. But here's some surprising news. Although they spend on average only half an hour reading a day, on paper or on screen, both groups say that reading is their favourite activity. While teenagers can watch television on their devices, it seems they prefer to watch on TV sets, with the majority having a TV set in their bedroom.

So is using technology more often a good thing? Some think having so many digital tools available make both tweens and teens more creative. However, in reality they are too busy using technology for other things and they don't actually create any art, music or writing with it. A more serious problem is that gamers, who spend the most time of both groups in front of a screen, are the least active.

From the survey, it's clear that both groups are spending too much time using technology and are in danger of damaging their health.
